**This permit is required for the assembly of more than 25 persons in a “Public Park”, or if the event is open to the general public. Permits are required for music, art, religious and other shows or displays in public parks.**

1. No person shall build any fire within “public parks” except in a designated stove or fire place. Cooking stoves may be used within parks if used in safe operating conditions. No fire or stove shall be left unattended and must be extinguished before its user leaves the park.
2. No person shall harm any bird or animal within any park.
3. No dog shall be permitted to run at large within any public park. All dogs shall be kept in control on a leash at all times. Owners of dogs are required to remove any waste left by their dog. No horses are allowed in parks.
4. No motor vehicles are allowed in parks except in designated roads or parking areas or as otherwise approved by Park Administration.
5. Park hours are 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.
6. No littering. Please dispose of cigarette butts in appropriate receptacles. Any trash created by the event must be removed or properly stowed by the event organizer.
7. Damage or removal of any plants, structures, or drinking fountains is prohibited.
8. No signs are allowed without permission from Park Administration.
9. No soliciting, selling or peddling without a specific permit from City Administration and Park Administration approval.
10. No person is allowed to conduct any activities that create a public nuisance. Public intoxication is prohibited.
11. Violation of any City Ordinances may result in being banned from park use.
12. **All organized events will require a certificate of insurance pertinent to the event.**

Applicant agrees to hold harmless, indemnify and defend the City of Heppner from all liability for injury or damage to persons or property arising out of Applicant’s use of the subject property, unless the injury or damage is caused by the sole negligence of the “City”. This permit is subject to cancellation by any Police Officer or City Official who determines that any City Ordinances or State Laws are being violated. All City Parks are public, being granted a permit does not guarantee exclusive use of the park.
